The Cambria County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is responsible for the review and approval of local plans and programs seeking federal and state funds for transportation improvements. The MPO jurisdiction includes all of Cambria County. Federal regulations for metropolitan planning require that the metropolitan transportation planning process include a proactive public involvement process that provides complete information, timely public notice, full public access to key technical and policy decisions, and supports early and continuing involvement of the public in developing transportation plans, studies, and Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs). The public participation process conducted by the Cambria County MPO will include the Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) Program of Projects (POP) and the Transit Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) projects. The public participation process will recognize that the MPO's public participation process satisfies CamTran's public participation requirement for the POP. These documents must also be properly advertised for public review and comment.

The Cambria County MPO is currently overseeing the biennial update to the Twelve Year Program (TYP) and the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Cambria County. Consistent with the Cambria County MPO's adopted Public Participation Plan (PPP), copies of the draft FFY 2023-2026 Highway and Bridge TIP, Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) Program of Projects (POP), Public Transit Transportation Improvement Program Projects, air quality conformity report, and other supportive documents are available for public inspection through June 28, 2022. These documents can be viewed on the Cambria County Planning Commission's website: www.cambriaplanning.org.
